THE SIXTH INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON TARDIGRADA (incorporating Gastrotricha) will be hosted by the British Antarctic Survey, at Cambridge, U.K. in August 1994.

Since the 5th. Symposium in the series in 1992, several interesting new developments have occurred in our understanding of these phyla. The meeting will provide an opportunity for discussion and analysis of new ideas.

The attractive and historic city of Cambridge is easily accessible by rail and coach from London and all London's airports. Accommodation will be arranged within one of the Cambridge Colleges, close to the City Centre.

TOPICS

Papers dealing with all aspects of tardigrade biology will be welcome. There will also be a session to include both 'High Latitude, High Altitude' and 'Cold Tolerance'. The Second Circular will include a call for abstracts.

SESSIONS

Registration will begin on Monday and sessions run from Tuesday to Thursday. There will be a poster session, and workshops are expected to form an important part of the conference.

PUBLICATION

At this point it is envisaged that publication of the proceedings will be limited to bound abstracts, in order to keep the cost down.
